Mary Hodorowicz, PhD, MSW, LCSW-C received her PhD and MSW from the University of Maryland, School of Social Work and her Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Pittsburgh. Mary is actively engaged in clinical practice, teaching and training, and evaluation research. Mary is a member of the Motivational Interviewing Network of Trainers, where she sits on an international committee supporting learning and use of motivational interviewing across the globe. In addition to motivational interviewing, other research and professional interests include mental and behavioral health treatment, substance use, social work teaching and training methods, child maltreatment prevention, and adoption related work.

Course Description:

This three hour course is designed to provide an introductory overview of Motivational Interviewing (MI) as a science supported intervention for behavior change, particularly focusing on facilitating conversations with older adults about substance use and symptoms of depression. Participants will have an opportunity for engaging in experiential learning via hands on skill practice. Lastly, we will review resources for further MI knowledge acquisition and skill development.
